"Flipped classroom is a form of blended learning in which students learn content online by watching video lectures, usually at home, and homework is done in class with teachers and students discussing and solving questions. Teacher interaction with students is more personalized - guidance instead of teaching. This is also known as backwards classroom, inverted classroom, reverse teaching, and the Thayer Method." - 8. The teacher posts additional information and resources that are necessary.
