He wants a human being to be liberated from past, theologies and political ideologies because a man binds with his past, theologies and political ideologies is not a pure seeker. A manhas many prejudices so he is in favour of such education which teaches a man how to liberate from above mentioned evils, as the liberation is a journey of heights which goes higher and higher, transcending oneself day after day. He explains, "when a person transcends himself in every respect, nothing remains to be transcended, then liberation happens."
- 2. Rajneesh agrees with the Upnishad Rishi who prays to God, "TamasoMaaJyotirgamaya", lead us from darkness to light. Education lead a man from ignorance to knowledge,

knowledge of one's true nature.

- 3. For him, "when something is drawn outwards from your centre is education." Here he talks about the original meaning of the word 'education'- 'to draw out'. He says the centre is full of love, compassion and all other good qualities, through education, one has to draw out this inner qualities of the soul and also the hidden potential of a man. Thus he accepts the truth of everybody's unique individuality. He wants education to help an individual to become what he is only in a seed form, what he is 'Actual'.
- 4. He says, education should teach a man to be great but at the same time, he should also be taught to put the mind aside.
- 5. For him, the centre of education is only love, knowledge is secondary, "real education is the art of fulfilling the heart of the man." He believes that through education, the heart of a man should be developed first then the mind (intelligence).
- 6. He firmly believes that education should be rebellious. Because our traditional educational system produces slaves, slaves of tradition, culture, beliefs. In order to bring change in an individual, he needs to be taught revolution.
- 7. His very original understanding about education is that education should manage energy. As excess energy needs to be transformed in a right direction, otherwise it will be wasted. So, right education directs and channelize the energy of an individual.
- 8. For him, true education should teach how to live life in its true sense.
- 9. Real education emphasizes the development of a whole man by developing his body, mind, heart and soul. Today's education focuses only on the development of mind and ignores rest three aspects of a human being.
- 10. Rajneesh proposed education to be divided in two parts; education for livelihood and education for death. To make education the complete education, university should have a double structure; one for the young people who will be taught how to live a life, and second for the old people who will be taught how to enter into the unknown world of death.

Conclusion:

Being a great teacher and philosopher, Rajneesh' ideas have weight to be implemented in the field of education. For him, the present education system has been rotten. New education system is the need of the hour. Present education system has many draw backs and negative points which Rajneesh has thought oven and tried to give solutions for them. He

is very original and revolutionary in his ideas regarding education. In this paper, all points regarding education have been discussed thoroughly.
